The content of your letter covering your concerns about the Birmingham High Court and the JCI0 has once again been noted. Nevertheless, I can only reiterate what was said in my letter sent on 23 February 2016 the fact that the Lord Chief Justice cannot intervene in or comment upon individual cases except those that come before him through the process of the courts.
